Simple changes that help you stay private and secure online.




Turn Off Location Sharing

WHY IT MATTERS

Apps can tag your location when you post — showing where you are right now, or where you've been.

WHAT TO DO

- Go to your phone settings and turn off "location" for social apps
- Or set it to "Only While Using App"
- Turn off "location history" too





Don't Overshare

BE CAREFUL ABOUT POSTING

- · Where you live
- When you're on vacation
- · Your phone number or email
- Big purchases or kids' details

WHY

This kind of info can be used by scammers, advertisers, or people you don't want watching.



Check Your Privacy Settings

EACH PLATFORM LETS YOU CONTROL WHO SEES YOUR POSTS AND PROFILE INFO Go to Settings → Privacy:

- Set posts to "Friends only"
- Hide your phone number and email
- · Block tracking for ads and data sharing





Clean Up Your Friends/Followers List

DO THIS MONTHLY:

- · Remove people you don't know
- · Decline requests from unverified profiles
- Don't share your info with strangers online even if they look friendly

Would I be OK with a stranger or scammer seeing this? If not — make it private, or skip it entirely.
